State law does not provide these options to students in the Classes of 2019 and beyond. Students in the Classes of 2019 and beyond will be expected to satisfy one of the original three pathways to graduation.
 1. 18 pts on 7 end of course exams
 2. 12 pts on work keys (Industry Credentials)
 3. Remediation free in English and math on ACT/SAT
